

Burnsview Student Athletic Fee Distribution



Fees paid by student athletes go directly into the general Athletics account. The fees are adjusted to account for the actual expenses associated with the level/grade of competition. This money is used for a variety of purposes:

1. **Uniforms** (replaced every few years and paid for primarily by athletic fees).
2. **Referees** (for each home game Refs are paid, \$50-120 per game, per ref. Sports like Volleyball and Basketball require two refs).
3. **Delta, Fraser Valley, and Provincial Playoff Costs** (including refs and hardware).
4. **Equipment**
 - *Team equipment*: volleyballs, basketballs, rugby balls, birdies, track equipment, etc.
 - *Game equipment*: pads for volleyball and rugby stands, volleyball antennas, game balls, scoring equipment, equipment to line the fields including paint, volleyball and basketball scorebooks, etc.
5. **First Aid Supplies** (including: tape, pro-wrap, band-aids, instant icepacks, scissors, gauze, the kit or case)
6. **Transportation** (coaches and students, where applicable).
7. **BC School Sports Registration** (provides insurance to protect our student athletes).
8. **Fraser Valley League Registration** for each sport.
9. **School T-shirts** (a specific sport t-shirt for each sport played for each student athlete).
10. **Tournament Costs** (each tournament typically costs between \$125-400)
11. **Coach expenses** (Criminal Records Checks mandatory for all community coaches, equipment such as whistles, ball bags, clipboards, whiteboards, etc.).
12. **Coach Appreciation Gifts** (typically a t-shirt and/or jacket to show our appreciation and encourage coaches to remain coaches at our school).
