DRY GRAD RULES

1. This is an event for Grade 12 graduating students of Burnsville, Delview, North Delta, and Sands Secondary schools only.
2. No tickets will be sold at the door.
3. This is a substance-free party. There is ZERO tolerance for alcohol, drugs, smoking, vaping, or e-cigarettes.
4. If a student is impaired, the procedures we will follow are:
 - The student will be assisted by first aid volunteers and/or the Delta Fire and Emergency Services
 - We will involve our Security team
 - Security will contact the parent/guardian of the student to pick them up and provide transportation home. The student cannot leave with another student or alone.
 - If needed, we will request assistance from Delta Police
5. We will have “concert-style” security onsite during the event.
6. No admission after 12:30am.
7. No re-entry privileges. If a student leaves, they cannot return.
8. All belongings, including bags, coats, purses, wallets, cellphones, cameras, and any other electronic devices must be checked in upon arrival. The Delta North Dry Grad committee is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
9. Please bring your ticket to the event. Photo ID (preferably school ID card) is required for entry if you do not have your ticket.
