#### Principal's Message – Don Younger

Don spoke about the incident that happened last week. Last Tuesday, January 19th an altercation happened between a Grade 9 and Grade 10 student. It occured at the end of Block B. One student did use a knife to another student. This is an isolated incident. Unable to provide details due to the ongoing investigation. There is a lot of false information going around. There has been no physical interaction prior to this incident. Both students are not attending class at this time. Continuing to support the police investigation. We have great staff here at Burnsview. Our goals are somewhat changing with having the key goals - building connections with our students and work with local agencies.

With the continuation of the pandemic situation, this year has been hard in getting to know the students as well as we normally do. We need to make a better effort in supporting our children during this time. The connection and communication is not being seen.

Quarter turnover. End of Semester 1/Quarter 1. Last day is February 2nd. There will be another "I" day on February 2nd. Quarter 3/Semester 2 will be starting on February 3rd. Continuing to keep the cohorts for Grade 8 through 10s. There is more flexibility with the Grade 11 & 12s.

The semester system with hybrid courses seems to be working well. Will be thinking of continuing with this system going forward.
