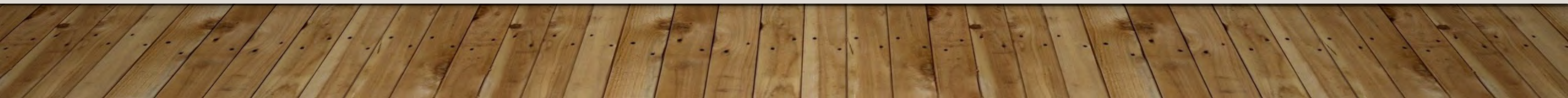
Students can take all 8 courses either at Burnsvew or online HomeQuest with Delta Access (no mixed schedules)

## Required Provincial Assessments for Graduation

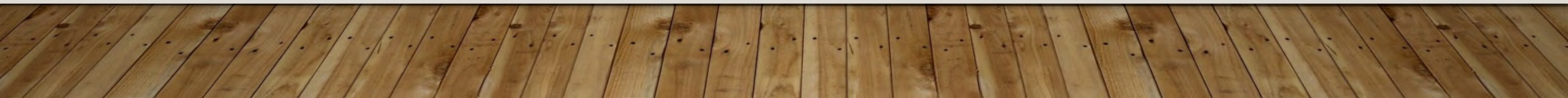
- 1) Literacy Assessment (Gr. 10)

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Assessments are electronic, 2 – 3 hours.

Students are registered for the assessments automatically

Students can rewrite assessments up to 3 times to improve their scores

\*In addition, French Immersion students will be required to write this assessment



## Credit Requirements for Graduation

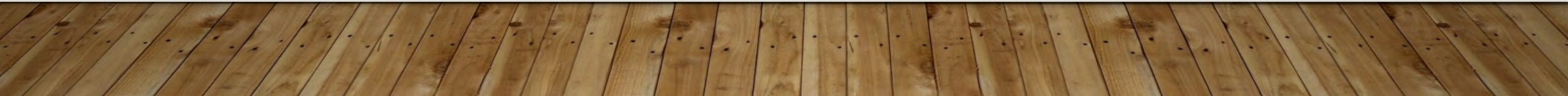
A minimum of 80 credits is required for grade 10, 11 and 12 → 16 of which must be at the grade 12 level.

One course is 4 credits.

External credits may apply. (High Level Music, Dance, Sports, Cadets, Scouting, Languages, Lifeguarding, Driver's Education Courses, Duke of Edinburgh, Girl Guides, etc.) See the counsellor for more information.

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Grad check will be done by your counsellor in grade 12 to make sure you have met the requirements to graduate.



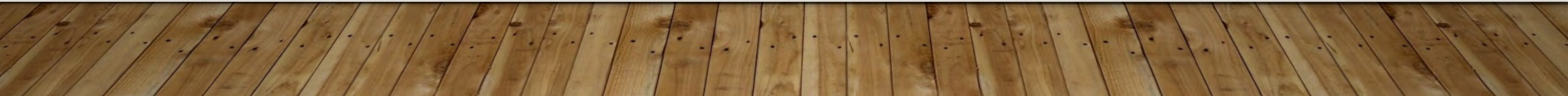
## External Credits

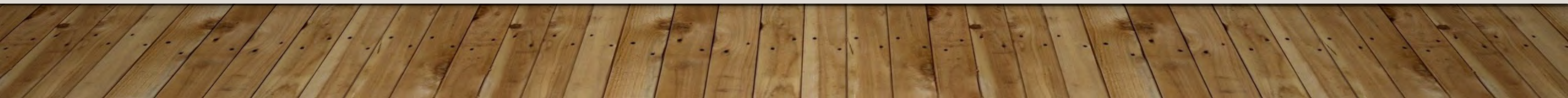


# First Day of School

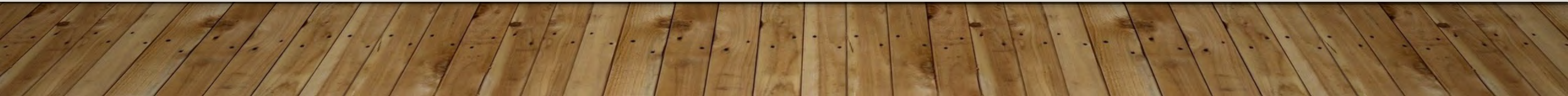

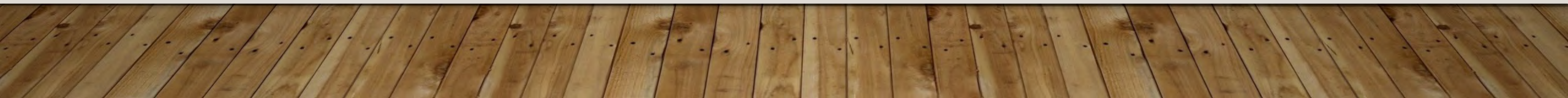
