## CREDIT REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION

One course is 4 credits

A minimum of 80 credits is required for grade 10, 11 and 12
$\rightarrow 16$ of which ( $=4$ courses) must be at the grade 12 level
$\rightarrow 4$ of which ( $=1$ course) must be of Indigenous (First Peoples) Content

External credits may apply: High Level Music, Dance, Sports, Cadets, Scouting, Languages, Lifeguarding, Driver's Education Courses, Duke of Edinburgh, Girl Guides, etc.
