





## A minimum of 80 credits is required for grade 10, 11 and 12

- → 16 of which (= 4 courses) must be at the grade 12 level
- → 4 of which (= 1 course) must be of Indigenous (First Peoples) Content

External credits may apply: High Level Music, Dance, Sports, Cadets, Scouting,
